You are advised that a Petition for Registration of a Foreign Support Order from the State of _____ has been filed with this Court and that you have an opportunity to contest the validity or enforcement of the order.

You are advised of the following:

- (1) That a registered order that is confirmed is enforceable as of the date of registration in the same manner as an order issued by a court of this state.
- (2) That a hearing to contest the validity or enforcement of the registered order must be requested no later than twenty (20) days after service of this notice.
- (3) That failure to contest the validity or enforcement of the registered order in a timely manner will result in confirmation of the order and enforcement of the order and the alleged arrearages and precludes further contest of that order with respect to any matter that could have been asserted.
- (4) The amount of arrearage under the support order is _____.

Please be advised that upon the registration of an income withholding order for enforcement, this Court will issue a withholding notice to your employer.

Should you wish to contest the validity or enforcement of this registered order, you must request a hearing no later the twenty (20) days after the date of service of this Notice of Registration by filing a motion with this Court.

You may also seek to vacate the registration, to assert any defense to an allegation of noncompliance with the registered order, or to contest the remedies being sought or the amount of any arrearages.

Failure to act in a timely fashion as set forth above will result in the order being confirmed by operation of law.
